



Princess pet tent

Add panache to your home's décor and give your pet the sweetest dreams ever! Adorned with jewels, this tent is just a suggested design of a "castle" fit for your little princess cat or dog!

materials

Palette

- *Delta* Ceramcoat Acrylics: Butter Cream, Dark Burnt Umber, Mendocino Red, Pop Ink, Royal Fuchsia, Think Pink, Touch O' Pink, White

Brushes

- *Loew-Cornell* La Corneille Golden Taklon: Wash/Glaze, Series 7550, 1"; Shader, Series 7300, #8, #12; Script Liner, Series 7050, #2

Supplies

- *Delta* Ceramcoat: Sparkle Glaze; Brush Cleaner; Textile Medium
- Crystal flat-backed rhinestones in variety of sizes
- *Beacon* Gem-Tac Permanent Adhesive

Surface

- Use your favorite internet search engine to search under "designer dog tent" or "transportable pet tent" for a suitable "castle"

preparation

(Note: Textile Medium can be added, following manufacturer's directions, to paints for softness to fabric, if desired.)

Trace patterns. Transfer animal skin border around door and use large flower pattern to randomly transfer flowers on roof. Draw a 1¹/₄"-wide border around outer roof edges.

painting instructions

Animal Skin

Use wash/glaze brush and Butter Cream to base animal skin borders and roof peek. Let dry. Transfer animal skin details. Use #8 shader and Dk. Burnt Umber to paint stripes working horizontally back and forth to create fuzzy edges.

Solid Flowers


Refer to worksheet. Transfer flowers at door entrance. Use wash/glaze brush and Pop Pink to base petals and center. Working wet-into-wet, use #12 shader to pull Royal Fuchsia shadow from center of petal out and to shade along bottom of center; use same brush to streak Touch O Pink highlights starting at tip of petal

pulling in and to highlight along top of center. Reinforce shadows with Mendocino Red using same brush and technique.

Lined Flowers

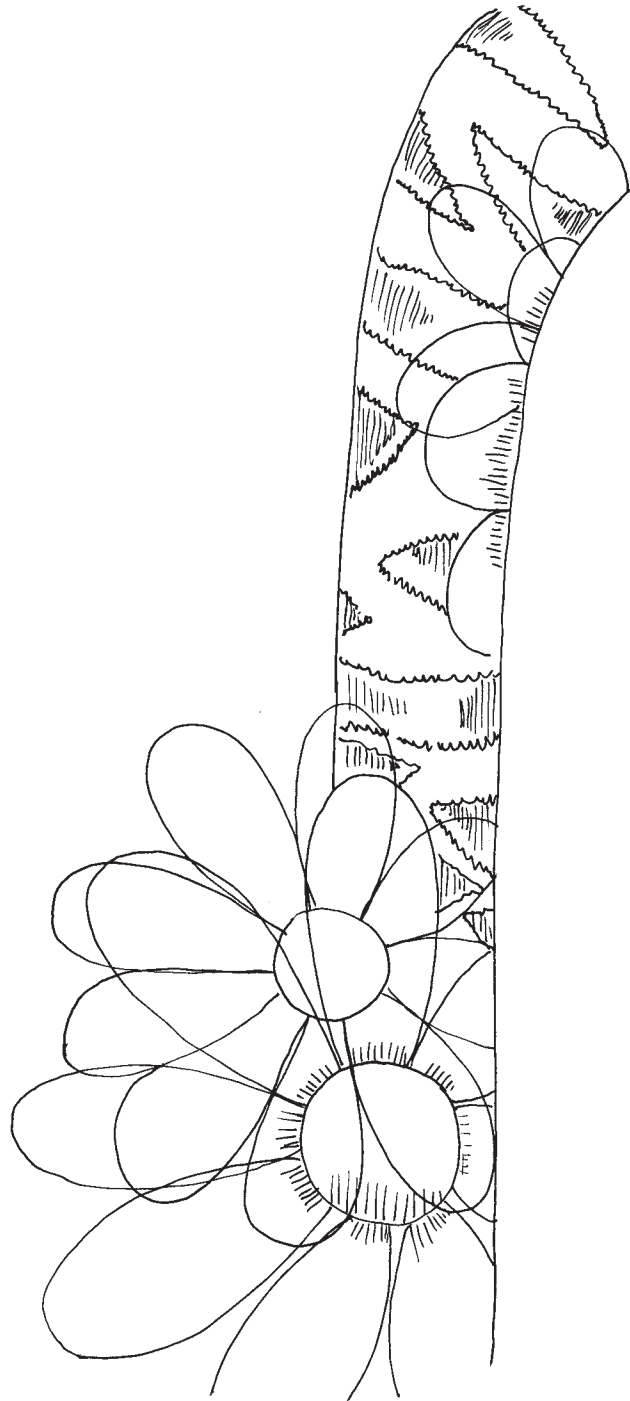
For white lined flowers, use script liner and White. For pink lined flowers, use same brush and Pop Pink; touch here and there with Think Pink.

Finishing

Add pink and white vertical stripes to front of roof as desired. Add Sparkle Glaze here and there to lined flowers or as desired. Randomly glue rhinestones.
